Volunteer Rules and Responsibilities

In the best interests of the children, the team at Volunteer Building Cambodia Community Centre requests you to work within the following guidelines:

Volunteers Rules

- 1. Do not give money or any kind of gift to individual children.
- 3. Dress standards apply at VBCCC. For ladies, shoulders must be covered, no low-cut tops, and shorts must be covered to the knee. For men, shorts to the knee. No offensive writing, pictures or alcohol advertising on clothing.
- 4. No foul language or inappropriate behaviour will be tolerated at the Community Centre.
- 5. Smoking and consumption of alcohol are not permitted in or around the Community Centre and grounds.
- 6. No violence.
- 7. No hugging of students.
- 8. No taking of photos or videos without permission.
- 9. Do not connect with students on social media, or share social media with them.
- 10. Do not take pictures of individual students.
- 12. Do not stay in a closed place with only l or 2 students.
- 13. Do not sit on tables.
- 13. Taking children outside of the Community Centre grounds is not permitted.
- 14. No use of your phone in the classroom.
- 15. Do not ask the student to undertake any personal tasks.
- 16. No wearing of a cap or a hat in the class

Volunteers Responsibilities

- 1. Assist the homeroom teacher in the class by:
 - a. Helping students to improve their pronunciation.
 - b. Helping students in the classroom while the homeroom teacher is teaching.
 - c. Boosting students' English skills.
 - d. Practising English with our students.
 - e. Involvement with class activities, both in the class and outdoors.
 - f. Helping students while they are reading in the library.
 - g. Helping the slower learners
 - h. Helping the students when they need extra support.
- 2. Supporting the teacher in managing class behaviour.
- 3. Creating a weekly lesson plan with the homeroom teacher.
- 4. Helping homeroom teachers to check students' daily homework.
- 5. Helping homeroom teachers to research teaching materials.
- 6. Helping our local teachers to improve their English.
- 7. Checking student's daily homework and giving them feedback
- 8. Modelling through your own actions and words.
